IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RESETTLEMENT ACTION PLAN FOR ANADARKO MOZAMBIQUE AREA 1 PROJECT

About the Project

In 2010, Anadarko made its first discovery in Rovuma Basin Area 1, in northern Mozambique. The company has discovered more than 75 trillion cubic feet of natural gas resources in Offshore Area 1 and is working to develop a Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) project in Afungi, Cabo Delgado.

The construction and operation of the LNG project will require the physical and economic displacement of more than 1500 households (HH). A detailed resettlement plan was prepared and approved by the Government of Mozambique.

Consultec was appointed to provide the following services:

- Verification and Updating services of Socio-economic data and assets of the families affected by the Anadarko Mozambique Area 1 project, during Phase 0 and Phase 1 of the project;
- Update of the socio-economic data and assets of those affected;
- Receiving grievances and complaints from those affected;
- Obtaining signatures on resettlement agreements and support in the transport of resettled persons' goods.
